There is never a need to admit people to the building unless you invited them. The Gatehouse can and will open the door if the Concierge is absent. Anyone can call a unit using the Enterphone System located in the vestibule and the Owner can open the door by pushing 9 on their phone.

Don't create a **security risk** by admitting anyone not invited by you!



If you see the woman pictured to the right, or anyone else in your unit, immediately call 911 and report you have an intruder. Then notify the Gatehouse that you have called the police, describe the person and ask that they watch for them. An intruder was successful in gaining access to our building and entering a handful of units. The culprit took a fair amount of cash from wallets, enough to tide her over for a few days! Everyone should exercise caution when entering and exiting the building and is encouraged to lock their doors even when in their condos. Kudos to Kim Renwick, Property Manager, for reporting the incident and sharing the photo with the Ottawa Police Department.



If you are expecting guests or service people to arrive, Please provide them with your entry number for the Front Door. They can call your suite directly and all you have to do is push 9 on your phone to let them in. There is also a Directory by name. If the

Concierge is not at the desk, and you have notified the Gatehouse, they can open the door.

Never allow access to ANYONE other than your own guests or service people.




Ve Vant You o Know
